



## Proposed Lake Kapowsin Aquatic Reserve – **Open House Meeting**

Lake Kapowsin is proposed as an aquatic reserve because it is a rare, undeveloped Puget lowland lake. The lake has a unique drowned cedar forest created when the Electron mudflow dammed Kapowsin creek, five hundred years ago. Lake Kapowsin contains important habitat for fish and other water dependent species. Current fishing access and opportunities would not be limited by reserve status.
